- Shipra Narang. UN-Habitat. What are the ongoing initiatives led by UN-Habitat on SDGs and more specifically on localization? -Special mention to the UN Local2030 Coalition- (including examples of relevant singular projects already performed or ongoing)
- Camilla Bruckner. UNDP. UNDP has a long record contributing to improve democratic governance and inclusive institutions worldwide. How do you bring that experience to the UN Local2030 Coalition and to SDG localization processes?
- Jonan Fernández. Basque Government. How does your government envision localization of the 2030 Agenda and multi-level governance? What means for the Basque Country hosting the UN Local2030 Coalition's Secretariat?
- Lisa Kurbiel & Marie-Sophie Reck. UN Joint SSG Fund. What are the ongoing initiatives led by the UN Joint SDG Fund regarding Localization of the SDGs? What are the lessons learned from the experience in supporting regional and local governments and communities so far?



- Loredana Magni. G20 Platform for the Localisation of the SDGs and Intermediary Cities (PLIC). Could you provide a short description of the the G20 Platform for the Localisation of the SDGs and Intermediary Cities? What was the initial intention to create this initiative by the Italian Presidency of the G20? Could you describe some examples of practical projects performed?

**Focus 2.** Balance of the main outcomes from the 2023 SDG Summit and the way ahead. The role of Localization as a cross-cutting topic & enabler. 30 minutes in total (6 minutes each):

- Shipra Narang. UN-Habitat. In terms of SDG's Localization, what aspects would you highlight from the results of the 2023 SDG Summit? What should be the role of the UN Local2030 Coalition in terms of working fields and priority goals in that framework?
- Camilla Bruckner. UNDP. What aspects would you highlight from the 2023 SDG Summit, and how those aspects should be embedded into Localization efforts worldwide?
- Jonan Fernández. Basque Government. Also according to the results of the 2023 SDG Summit, what are, in your view, the main tasks ahead for the UN Local2030 Coalition Secretariat? What are the objectives and results that should be prioritized?
- Lisa Kurbiel & Marie-Sophie Reck. UN Joint SDG Fund. How will the SDG Joint Fund plan to support the results of the 2023 SDG Summit, including the prioritized High Impact Initiatives? What role will localization have in this scenario? What would be the tools to address SDG localization in coming years?
- Loredana Magni. G20 Platform for the Localisation of the SDGs and Intermediary Cities (PLIC). What are the challenges for the implementation of SDGs at the G20 countries and the next steps planned until the end of the decade at PLIC? How will that work plan to interact with other existing international initiatives?

3 minutes (15 total) conclusion-summary of each panellist answering the question: What will be the main challenges for the international alliances -in global terms- to be have success on the localization of the 2030 Agenda? What is the contribution of these alliances to do not leave no one behind?
