Objectives

- 1). To create awareness of the dignity & equal rights of a girl child in our society. In our society, girls have been regarded bride materials, denying them access to education but our intervention advocates & empowers our societies to support girls that they may fully participate in the social, economic and spiritual development of their communities.
- 2). To raise funds for the education of needy girls in our society
- 3). To solicit funds for the renovation of our youth training centre in Kamuli

Activities

- Morning Session: Charity Walk, Girl Voices, Fundraising
- Afternoon Session: Mentorship, Christian / Life Skill, Career, Health & Reproductive Workshops For Students & General Public
- Lunch & donation of sanitary kits to girl Students.
- Evening Session: Charity Public Music Concert.

All proceeds go:

- 1). To cater for the education of our 22 supported needy girl students (\$2,000 pa)
- 2). To buy re-usable sanitary kits (that last for a year) to over 500 needy school girls in Kamuli(\$4,000 pa). Lack of hygiene supplies has for the past years resulted into girl school dropouts to avoid shame during their menstrual cycles. Our intervention makes them stay in school with comfort & concentration.
- 3). To renovate our Orphanage / youth training & vocational centre in Kamuli & equip it with training equipment i.e Tailoring machines, Computers, etc (\$ 12,000)
